Since May 1964, SANParks have engaged members of the public as volunteers known as Honorary Rangers (HR) to assist and get involved in many efforts to conserve our country's heritage. Currently there are 23 HR regions serving the 24 National Parks, including the Kruger National Park and Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park.

SANParks is looking to transform the HR Corps to incorporate more Historically Disadvantaged South Africans. To this end, the intention is to start a new region in the south of Johannesburg covering Soweto, Lenasia and surrounds.

If volunteer work is up your alley and giving back to your community through nature and all that it has to offer is what grabs you, this is your chance (Not to mention the wonderful opportunities to be involved with Parks).

Ideally we are looking for only 20 suitable applicants who fit the profile to start off the Region, which will most probably be based In Lenasia. Once the 20 candidates have been identified, the Region will be officially launched by SANParks.
